MS NIBRS CERTIFICATION CHECKLIST

Getting Started

- 1. Have a Records Management System (RMS)? Check with your vendor to ensure your RMS Software product (if applicable) is NIBRS compliant.
- 2. If you do not use an RMS, decide if your agency will procure NIBRS software/hardware.
- 3. Does your agency experience a small amount of incidents each month? The Repository Web Interface includes the Incident Editor which allows agencies to enter Group A Incidents, Group B Offenses and Zero Reports. Contact us for more information.
 - a. Agencies utilizing the Incident Editor will complete testing incidents before beginning the certification process.
- 4. NIBRS Training Modules available through the Law Enforcement Enterprise Portal (LEEP) in the Justice Connect community. Agencies may also request an E-Learning Series NIBRS CD by contacting <u>UCRTrainers@leo.gov</u>
- 5. Map state statutes to NIBRS offense codes.
- 6. Implement NIBRS RMS.
- Complete the *Law Enforcement Agency Contact/Modification Form* and submit to <u>MSNIBRS@dps.ms.gov</u>. This form can be downloaded from our website: <u>https://www.nibrs.dps.ms.gov</u> or can be emailed by request.
- 8. Pretest data against NIBRS validation rules:
 - a. MS Crime Insight Repository <u>https://mstest.beyond2020.com/</u>
 - i. *Law Enforcement Agency Contact/Modification Form* must be completed to receive username and password to access Crime Insight.
 - b. NIBRS pre-certification tool for flat file submission <u>https://nibrs.search.org/nibrs-web/</u>
 i. Users must create an account. There is no cost for the account.
 - c. NIBRS XML Conformance Testing Assistant (XCOTA)Tool for XML submissions <u>https://datastandards.cjis.gov/</u>
 - d. RMS agencies <u>must</u> pretest a minimum of 2 data submission files and Incident Editor Agencies must complete 2 Group A, 2 Group B and 1 Zero pre-test Incident Reports.
- Complete the *NIBRS Certification Testing Request Form* and submit to <u>MSNIBRS@dps.ms.gov</u>. This form can be downloaded from our website: <u>https://www.nibrs.dps.ms.gov</u> or can be emailed by request. Pretesting data (outlined above) MUST be completed prior to submitting this form.
- 10. Mississippi NIBRS will contact your agency to begin the certification process and provide further instructions.
